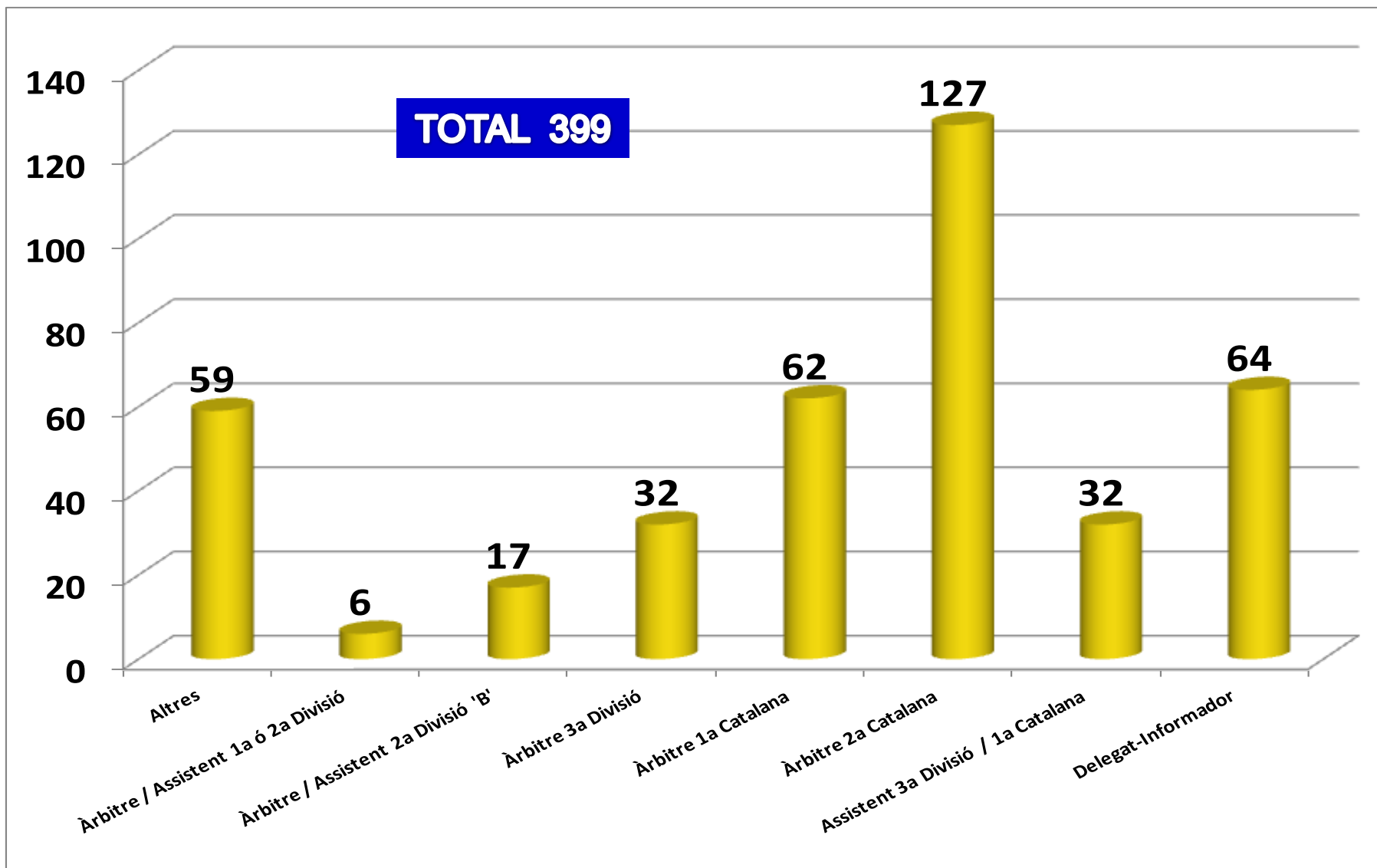

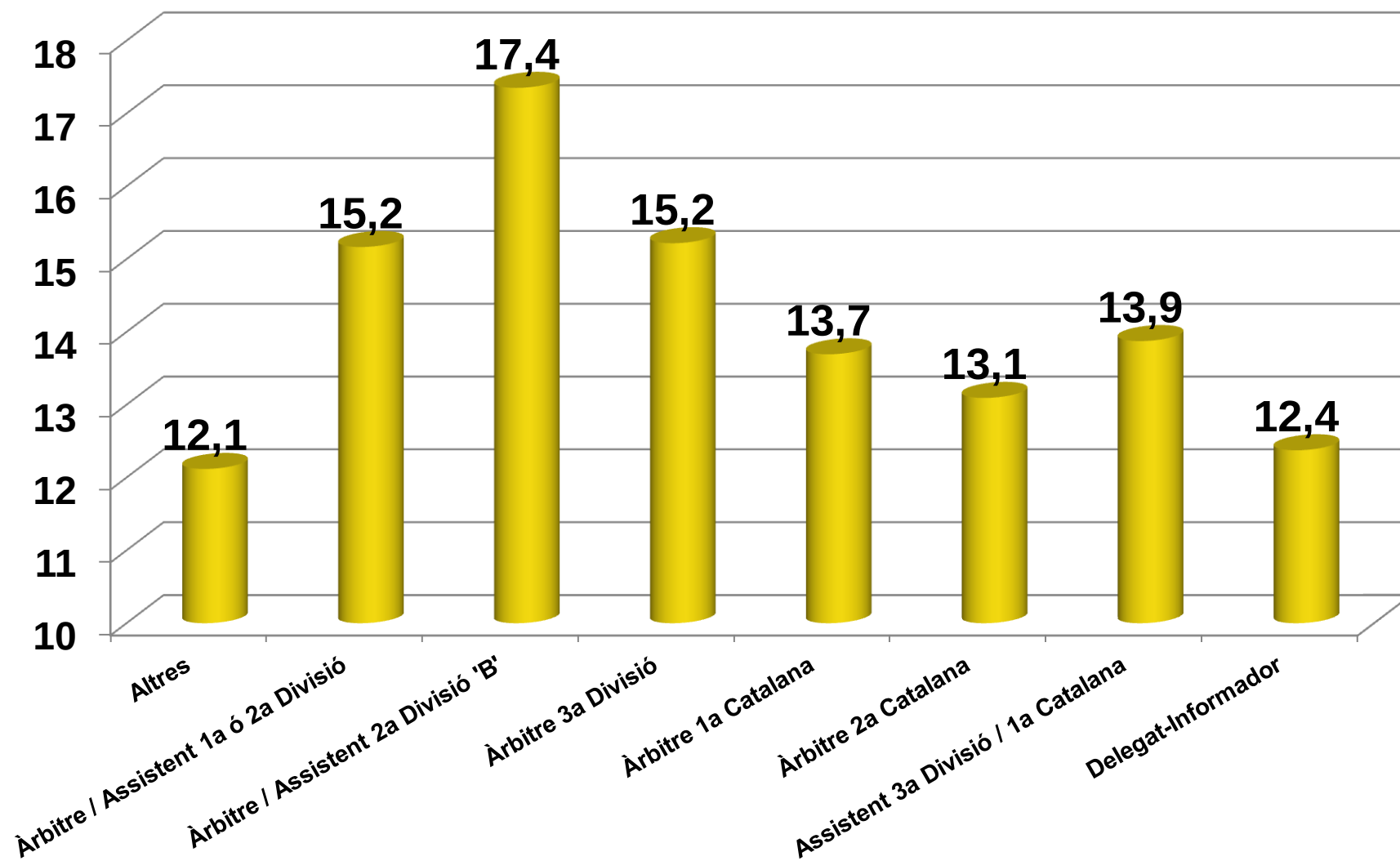

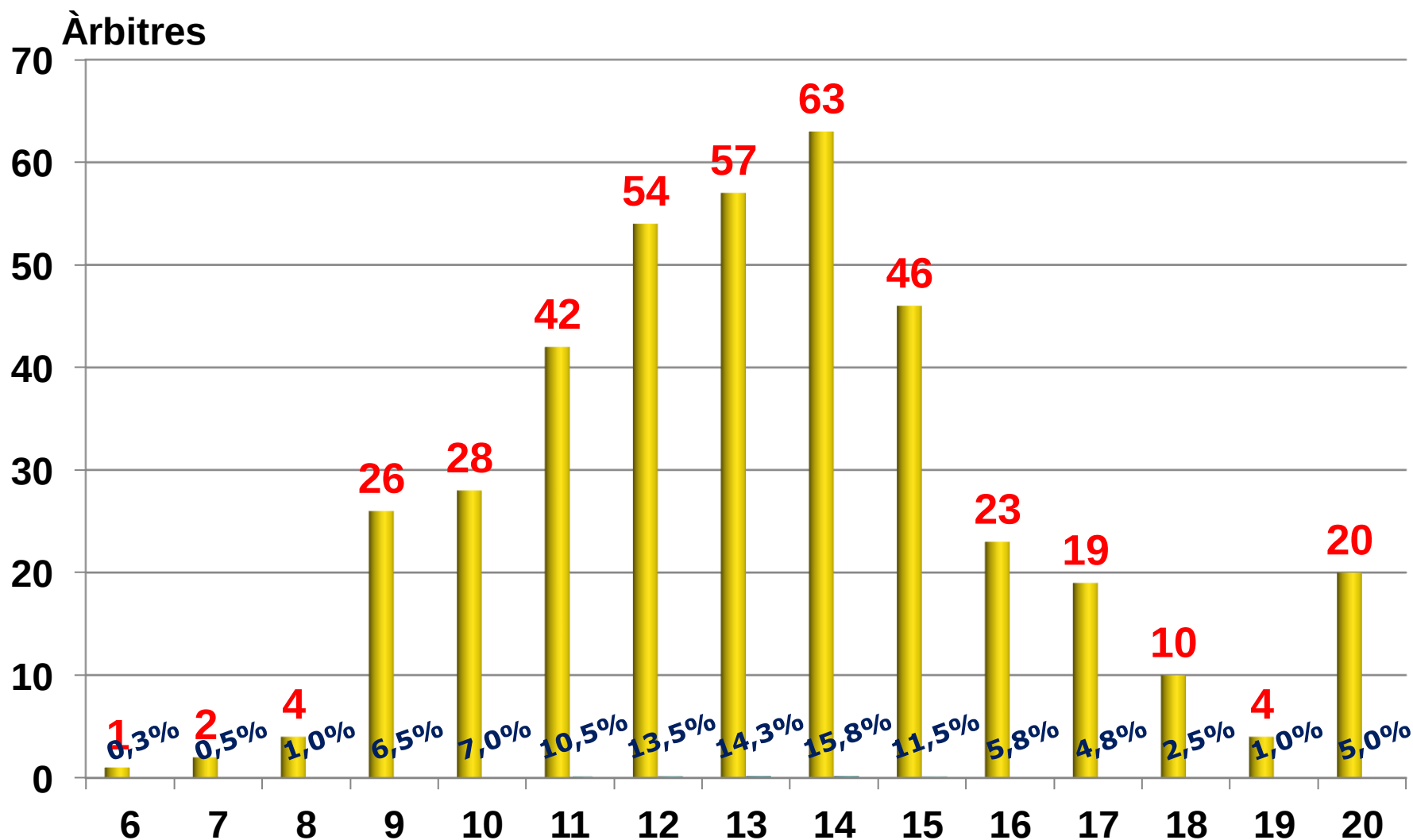

Explanation

Jugada 1	
Avantatge	The referee delays his whistle and then applies advantage, which results in a very promising attack. Team benefit was correctly considered
Jugada 2	
No Avantatge	After reckless challenges advantage should be applied only when there is clear team benefit, i.e. a clear promising attack. In this case considering the number and position of the attackers and defenders, play should be better stopped and the offender cautioned.
Jugada 3	
No Avantatge	When considering applying advantage, the referee should take into account team-benefit. If there is merely possession of the ball, play should be better stopped and a free kick awarded.
Jugada 4	
No Avantatge	Referee initially decides to apply advantage, but when he realises that there is no team benefit, correctly stops play and awards a free kick. Referee should take into consideration also the result and the time of the match (minute 90+1, foul against the winning team).

Jugada 5	
Avantatge	As the attacking team has a very promising attack, the referee should have held the whistle and applied advantage.
Jugada 6	
Control Correcte	Referee decides to take a preventative action in a calm and composed manner, with good and effective body language.
Jugada 7	
Control Incorrecte	Referee first fails to stop play for a foul play by Yellow Nr.10. When play is stopped for another offence, the referee is too slow to react when confrontation occurs. Also the referee's management of Green Nr. 6 should be stronger and preventative.
Jugada 8	
Control Correcte	When two players collide with heads, play should be stopped immediately to allow treatment

Jugada 9	
Control Incorrecte	When the goalkeeper is blatantly off his goal-line and / or players clearly encroach in the penalty area, referees must take action in accordance with the Laws of the Game. In this particular cases, the penalty kick should have been retaken and the goalkeeper cautioned. Referee must take a position which allows him to control the taker and possible encroachment, while the goalkeeper's position should be the responsibility of the AAR
Jugada 10	
Control Incorrecte	It would be wiser to stop play for a first offence on Yellow 10 and so to prevent any further escalation.
Jugada 11	
Tir lliure directe; no targeta	Defender's arm is not in natural position, so a defender is responsible for making hand contact with the ball. A direct free kick should be awarded. Given that the attacker would still need to control high ball and the proximity of other defenders, a promising attack is not clearly stopped, so disciplinary action is not necessary.
Jugada 12	
Tir lliure directe; amonestació	The white player deliberately handles the ball and stops a promising attack. A direct free kick is awarded and the offender is correctly cautioned. Jugada 13	
No falta; no targeta	Defender's arm is in a natural position with the ball coming from a short distance. Play is correctly allowed to continue.
Jugada 14	
Penalty; no targeta	A defender handles the ball with arm in unnatural position. The penalty kick is correctly awarded. Disciplinary sanction is not justified, as the defender does not stop a promising attack.
Jugada 15	
Tir lliure directe; amonestació	Red Nr. 10 deliberately handles the ball and stops a promising attack of the opponents. A direct free kick is awarded and the offender, who has been already cautioned, is correctly sent-off for second cautionable offence.
Jugada 16	
Penalty; no targeta	A defender clearly holds back an attacker. The penalty kick should have been awarded. As he does not stop a promising attack, disciplinary sanction is not necessary. The referees should be strict and strong to punish such unsporting acts

Jugada 17	
Penalty; amonestació	A defender clearly holds back an attacker and prevent him to participate in the attacking action. The penalty kick should have been awarded. The offender may also be cautioned for unsporting behaviour. Since there is another defender holding an opponent, this could be illustration of the defending team's tactics, which the referees should be aware of and take strict action
Jugada 18	
Tir lliure directe; amonestació	The white player first pulls the shirt and then kicks an opponent in an unsporting manner. However, the offender uses no excessive force or brutality, so he should be cautioned.
Jugada 19	
Tir lliure directe; amonestació	A player stamps on the opponent's foot. Such challenges are reckless and should be punished with a yellow card
Jugada 20	
Tir lliure directe; amonestació	A player plays the ball, but also makes strong unfair physical contact with the opponent with his trailing leg. The challenge is reckless and the offender should be cautioned. When making such a tackle, the player must play the ball in a fair manner
