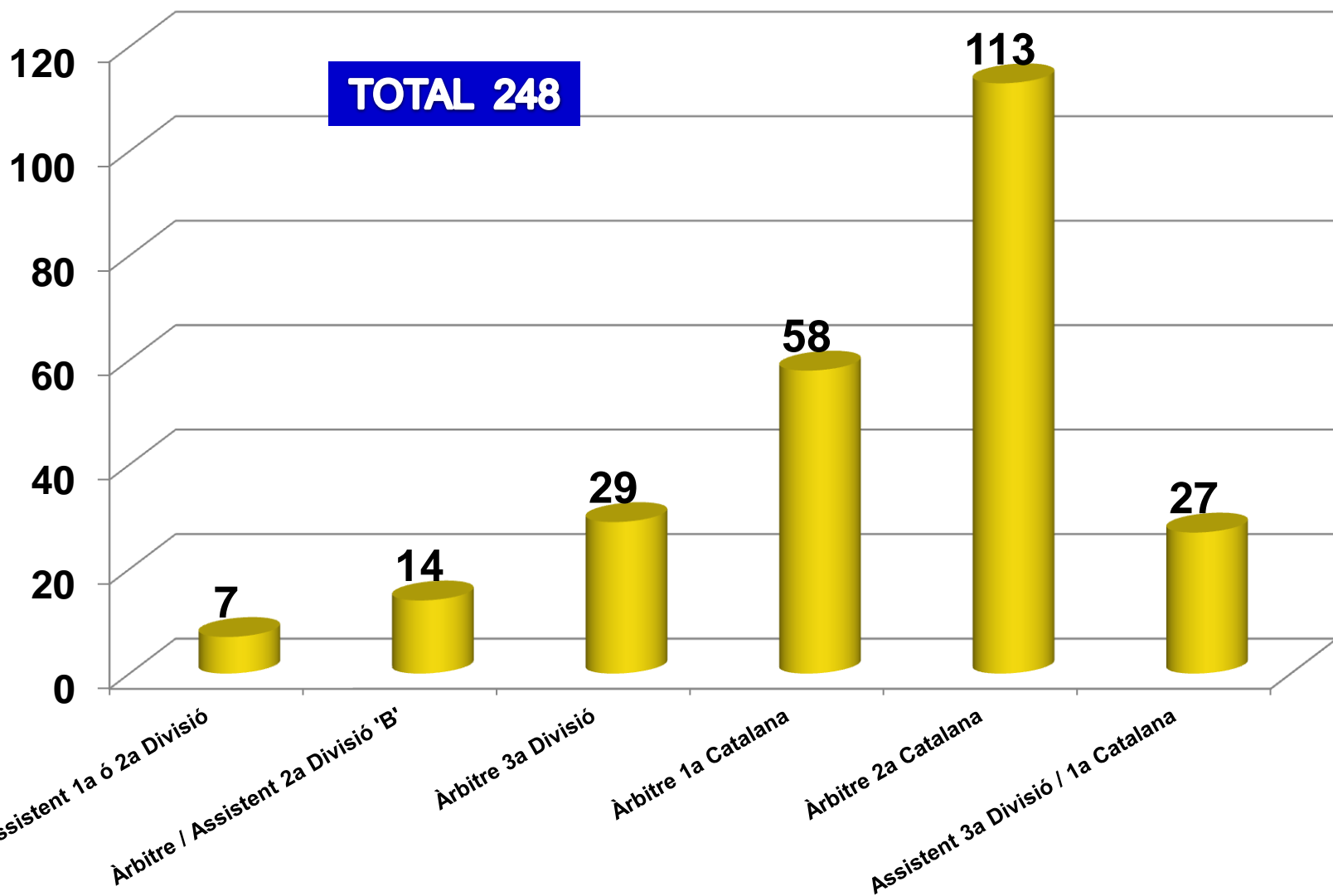

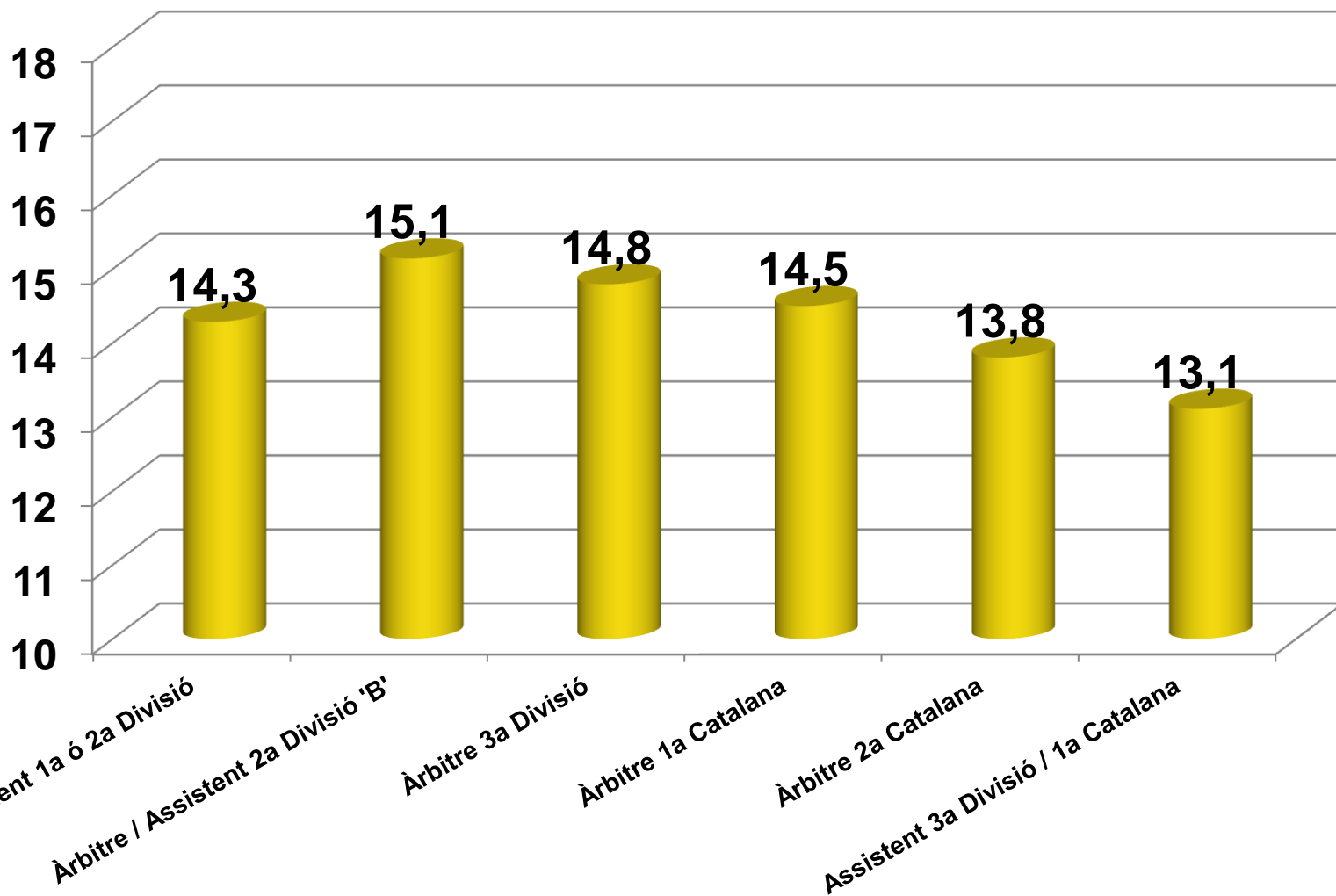
Participants per categoria

Promig respostes correctes

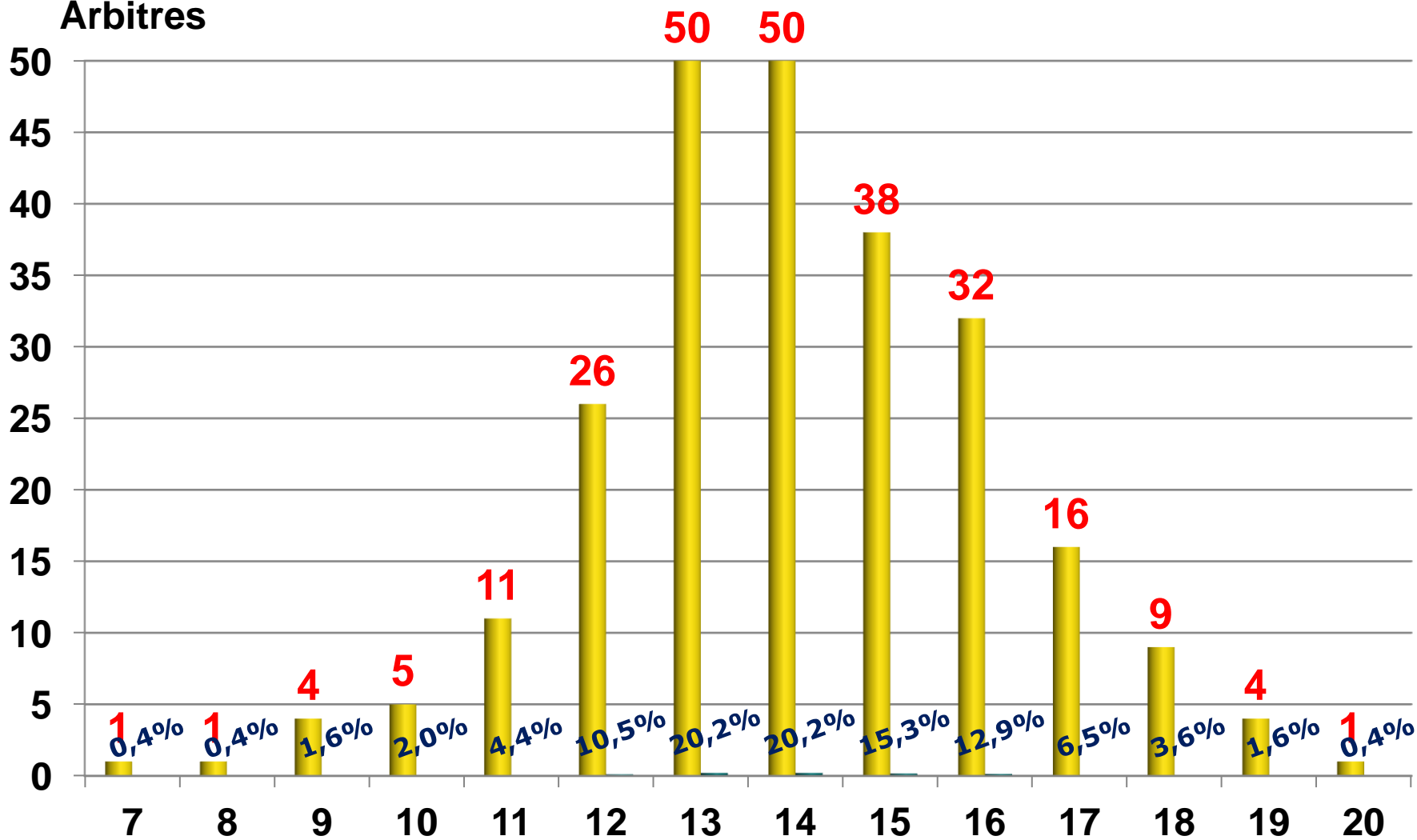

Explanation

(original from UEFA)

Jugada 1	
No falta, No targeta	The ball strikes the arm of Yellow 15 as he falls to the ground. Given that the arm was in a natural position for someone who was falling to the ground, the referee correctly allowed play to continue.
Jugada 2	
Penalti, Amonestació	Both arms of the defender are raised and out from the body and in these circumstances a penalty kick should be awarded and the defender cautioned.
Jugada 3	
Tir lliure Directe, Amonestació	The Red defender deliberately raises his arm to stop the ball from going towards the White 42. A direct free kick and a yellow card is correctly given by the referee.
Jugada 4	
Penalti, No targeta	The arm of the Black defender is clearly raised in the air in an unnatural position and the referee correctly awards the penalty kick. The player is not cautioned as the offence did not stop a promising attack.

Jugada 5	
Tir lliure Indirecte, Amonestació	The goalkeeper is late and is not playing the ball, but he does also not commit any offence either. The attacker falls to the ground in anticipation of the contact by the goalkeeper in trying to deceive the referee. The offender should be cautioned for unsporting behaviour – simulation. The referees are reminded of importance to assess such incidents from good angle and that players who are guilty of simulation must be cautioned strictly and consistently!
Jugada 6	
Tir lliure Indirecte, Amonestació	The attacker uses slight contact with the opponent and falls to the ground. He attempts to deceive the referee to get the penalty kick awarded. The attacker should be cautioned for unsporting behaviour - simulation. Referees are reminded that any player's act intended to deceive the referee MUST be punished with a indirect free kick and with a yellow card!
Jugada 7	
Tir lliure Indirecte, Amonestació	An attacker decides to fall down in anticipation of the contact with the defender. He is clearly attempting to deceive the referee into awarding a penalty kick and must be cautioned for unsporting behaviour - simulation. This clip also illustrates the importance of efficient teamwork also regarding the incidents in the penalty area. In this case it is AAR with the best viewing angle.
Jugada 8	
Correcte decisió de l'àrbitre	The referee correctly delays his whistle to assess if the team had gained a clear advantage before correctly recalling play.

Jugada 9	
Correcte decisió de l'àrbitre	The referee correctly delays his whistle to allow a very good advantage. At the next stoppage in play White 25 was correctly cautioned.
Jugada 10	
Ventatge	Two incidents highlighted when the referee correctly allows the play to continue following a careless challenge, however when the following reckless challenge takes place without any advantage occurring, the referee correctly decides it is more of a team benefit to stop play.
Jugada 11	
No ventatge	Two incidents highlighted when the referee correctly allows the play to continue following a careless challenge, however when the following reckless challenge takes place without any advantage occurring, the referee correctly decides it is more of a team benefit to stop play.
Jugada 12	
Tir lliure Indirecte (offside)	The White Nr. 10, having been in offside position, gains an advantage by being in that position, as he plays the ball that is deflected to him off an opponent. Play should be stopped for offside offence.



Explanation

Jugada 13	
Continúa joc (no offside)	The attacker in offside position is not involved in active play, as he does not interfere with any of his opponents. Play is correctly allowed to continue.
Jugada 14	
Continúa joc (no offside)	Two attackers are in offside position. However they are not involved in active play, as they are not interfering with play nor with any opponent (they are not challenging an opponent for the ball, nor are they clearly obstructing the opponent's line of vision). The scorer, at the moment the ball was played was not in an offside position. The AR's should be reminded to adopt the "wait and see" technique.
Jugada 15	
Tir lliure Indirecte (offside)	A player in offside position is challenging an opponent for the ball and therefore interfering with an opponent. Play should be stopped for offside offence.
Jugada 16	
Continúa joc (no offside)	A player in offside position is not involved in active play as he is not interfering with play nor with an opponent (he is not challenging an opponent for the ball). Play should be allowed to continue.

Jugada 17	
Tir lliure Indirecte (offside)	After shot at goal, ball is saved by defender on the goalline. The attacker in offside position (even though he is momentarily off the field, he is considered to be in play, i.e on the goal-line) gains an advantage by being in that position, as he plays the ball that is played to him from a deliberate save by an opponent. Play should be stopped for offside offence.
Jugada 18	
Penalti, Expulsió	A defender deliberately handles the ball which would clearly enter the goal. As the defender by deliberately handling the ball denied a goal, the penalty kick should be awarded and the defender should be sent off.
Jugada 19	
Penalti, Expulsió	A defender unfairly uses his arms and holds back an opponent and by doing so clearly prevents him heading the ball towards the goal from short distance. Taking into consideration that the opponent would have had a clear and unobstructed possibility for heading the ball had he not been unfairly impeded and short distance from the goal, the defender unfairly denied an obvious goal-scoring opportunity. A penalty kick should be awarded and the defender sent off.
Jugada 20	
Penalti, Amonestació	The goalkeeper trips an attacker who has control of the ball. Considering the direction of the movement of the attacker and the ball, an obvious goal-scoring opportunity is not denied. However, the goalkeeper stops a promising attack. The penalty kick is awarded and the goalkeeper cautioned.
